WHY UNITE'S NHS MEMBERS ARE TAKING STRIKE ACTION



Unite's NHS members in England voted to reject the government's pay deal because it was an insult to NHS workers' professionalism and dedication.

It was below inflation so yet another cut to their pay.

Some NHS workers are turning to foodbanks to get by.

The government's deal will inflame the chronic recruitment and retention crisis which is already threatening patient care.

Further, Unite remains seriously concerned that the deal is not NEW MONEY but will instead be taken from current NHS budgets. We do not want patients to suffer.

We fear that the Westminster government is deliberately running down our NHS for privatisation.

We cannot tolerate this any longer so we are taking a stand.

FACT: 12 YEARS OF PAY CUTS HAS CAUSED A CRUSHING STAFF CRISIS.

There are now over 133,000 vacancies in the NHS.

FACT: FAIR PAY IS A WIN-WIN

For every £1 spent on increased pay, the Treasury gets 80p back through boosted tax income and increased spending on the high street. Fair pay is a WIN-WIN for the country and the NHS.

FACT: YOUR MONEY IS BEING WASTED ON AGENCY STAFF

£4.3bn has been spent on agency staff over five years to cover vacancies. That's money which could be used to pay staff fairly and keep them in our NHS.
